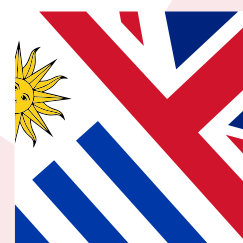

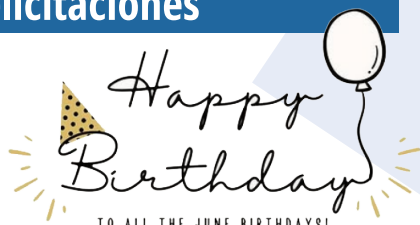

Royal Visit to Canada

King Charles III and Queen Camilla recently visited Canada for a two-day state visit, marking the King's first official trip to the country as sovereign. They arrived in Ottawa on May 26, 2025, where they were welcomed with a red-carpet ceremony by Governor General Mary Simon, Prime Minister Mark Carney, and a ceremonial guard of honour. Their visit was filled with significant engagements that reinforced the bond between Canada and the monarchy.

On the first day, the royal couple attended a community event at Lansdowne Park, where they interacted with Canadians from diverse backgrounds, including Indigenous leaders and youth. At Rideau Hall, King Charles held private audiences with the Governor General and Prime Minister, while Queen Camilla was formally sworn in as a member of the King's Privy Council for Canada. They also participated in a ceremonial tree-planting event, continuing a tradition upheld by previous royal visits.

The second day of their visit featured a grand procession through downtown Ottawa in a horse-drawn carriage, escorted by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Musical Ride. King Charles delivered a speech from the throne at the Senate of Canada, marking the first time in nearly 50 years that a British monarch has done so in Canada. His speech emphasized Canada's sovereignty, referencing the national anthem with the phrase: "The true north is indeed strong and free." The visit concluded with a wreath-laying ceremony at the National War Memorial, honouring Canada's fallen soldiers.

The trip was widely regarded as a success, strengthening ties between Canada and the monarchy. It took place amid political tensions with the U.S., with some analysts suggesting it was a symbolic reaffirmation of Canada's independence. The King was reportedly touched by the warm reception, with crowds spontaneously singing "God Save the King" and "O Canada."
